AWARD CRITERIA AND NOMINATION RULES

APPLICATION DEADLINE: DECEMBER 3, 2021

- The Paul E. Kanjorski Advocacy Scholarship, established in 2011, is awarded annually by CrossState Credit Union Association to honor former Pennsylvania Congressman Paul Kanjorski, who supported many legislative efforts on behalf of credit unions. The scholarship is designed to send one young professional to the CUNA Governmental Affairs Conference, February 27 - March 3, 2022, in Washington, D.C.
- The applicant must be an employee or volunteer of a member credit union, and between the ages of 18-35. The recipient of the Kanjorski Scholarship will receive free registration and lodging and will be reimbursed for the cost of meals and transportation.
- The questionnaire must be typewritten, completed in full, signed by the applicant and the applicant's supervisor, and returned by **December 3, 2021** to: Paul E. - The decision of the Association Awards Committee will be final. Employees of the CrossState Credit Union Association and its affiliates, members of their immediate families, and current members of the Board of Directors are ineligible for this award.
